

# The TagesTicket & the TagesTicketPLUS – All Important Information in a Nutshell!

## Validity

Valid for one day (on the day the ticket is validated until 3am the next day).

## Using the TagesTicket

The TagesTicket is either valid for one adult and up to two children aged between 6 and 14 years old or for three children aged between 6 and 14 years old.

## Using the TagesTicketPLUS

The TagesTicketPLUS is either valid for two adults and up to four children aged between 6 and 14 years old or for six children aged between 6 and 14 years old.

## Additional charge for night lines

An additional charge must be paid for the use of the BSAG night lines, the VWG night express lines and the „Nachtschwärmer“ (€1.00 per night and person or as a 4-trip ticket for €3.40).

## Area of validity

Valid on all local public transport (buses, trams and trains) in the VBN region within the price level of your purchased ticket.

## Travelling with bicycles

Taking your bicycle with you is no problem at all on VBN buses and trains. In order to do so, you will need a bicycle ticket. This is available as a TagesTicket for €1.50 (price levels I, II, A, B and S) or for €3.00 (for the entire VBN region).

## Can the ticket be transferred?

## ! Travelling with children in the VBN region

Children aged up to and including 5 years old can travel in VBN public transport free of charge with all tickets.

## How to get your ticket.

Children under 6 travel free-of-charge in the entire VBN region.

- You can purchase TagesTickets (day tickets)
  - at the advance ticket offices and from the transport companies' customer service centres
  - in all buses from the bus personnel
  - from the ticket machines on board the BSAG trams and NordWestbahn and EVB trains
  - from other ticket machines, e.g. at the stations
- NB: on the DB Regio AG and metronom trains, no VBN tickets are sold. You must purchase these from the ticket machines before travelling.

Of course, virtually all buses and trains are pushchair and wheelchair accessible.

### Remarks on the price regions

- 1 Price level I (Bremen) = for travel in Bremen-Stadt (city area) or Bremen-Nord (North Bremen), as well as for travel with the BSAG between Bremen-Stadt (city area) and Bremen-Nord (North Bremen).
- 2 Price level II (Bremen) = for travel with regional trains and regional bus companies between Bremen-Stadt (city area) and Bremen-Nord (North Bremen).
- 3 Price level S = for travel between Bremen and the surroundings of Lower Saxony, e.g. Bremen – Lilienthal or Bremen-Nord (North Bremen) – Schwanewede.
- 4 Price level A = the price for travel within one community, e.g. Delmenhorst. Price level B-H = the price is based on the number of zones travelled. (Price level B applies for 2 zones, for example when travelling from Zeven to Tarmstedt. Price level C applies for travel within three zones. Price level H allows unlimited travel in the entire VBN region.)
